up casks trading for
yams

Wednesday October 11
Ship lying at
anchor crew employed setting
up fore rigging cutting wood
on shore the cooper setting
up casks squally weather
with heavy rain

Thursday October 12
Continues squally
crew employed setting up keel
logs cutting wood and the
cooper setting up casks
sent a boat off to trade for
yams

Friday October 13
Ship lying at anchor
crew employed getting wood and
water the boat got back
with yams the cooper setting
up casks
