Saturday October 14
Ship lying at anchor crew employed getting wood and water and stowing it in the fore hold

Sunday October 15
Ship lying at anchor the crew ashore

Monday October 16
Ship lying at anchor crew employed getting wood and water sent the harbor and mist boat of to trade for goods with a crew of natives

Tuesday October 17
Ship lying at anchor crew employed getting wood and water (at) dark finished and got the ship ready for sea the boats arrived with goods and cocoa nuts

Wednesday October 18
A day light got under way and passed out of the Bay Sam Loom and Alfred Canacker deserted during the night this day ends with a light breeze from the SE ship heading SE all sail set

at anchor in Makira Bay 1878

Thursday October 19 Sea account
First part light breeze from SE ship heading SE middle part squally look in light sails at nine AM rose Kemel Island at twelve passed between Kemel and Belona island a strong breeze and squally

Friday October 20
First part a fresh breeze and squally ship heading SE middle part a fresh breeze and smoky weather later part the same ship heading SE

Lon 158-38

Saturday October 21
Fine weather and a fresh breeze ship heading SE wind from the E
Lat 15-37

Sunday October 22
Fine weather from the E ship heading SE
Lat 17-57
Lon 157-28

Monday October 23
Fine weather and a light breeze from the E ship heading SE
Look in the harbor boat repaired and cleaned her for painting and put her out
Lat 18-58
Lon 157-21
