SE a heavy cross sea

Gale from the S W middle part
more moderate later part
Calm and a heavy sea
no observations

Monday November 6 First part Calm
middle part a fresh breeze
and over cast from the S W
later part wind hauled to
the S W a strong Gale hoove
to under close reef main
topsail on the port lack
heading W Land a big head
ing to the E Lat 33-03
Lon 157-41

Tuesday November 7 First part a fresh
breeze from the S W
middle part moderate later part
a fresh breeze from the S Ship
heading S W all sail set
Crew Employed setting up
port-mizen rigging
