gale breeze and thick with rain
squalls middle part wind
hailed to the S later part
a fresh breeze with rain from
the S main sail and Stears
to the N no observations

Tuesday Novem 21
First part a strong
breeze from the S middle part
a light air Ship heading to the N
later part a fresh breeze from
the NW Ship heading NE
Lat 35-58
Lon 152-98

Novem 22
Throught this day some
light weather Ship heading
to the SE took a British
dark bound to Newcastle Whaler
day from Dunedin Lat 35-40

Novem 23
First and middle
part a light breeze from the NW
later part a fresh breeze and
