

Bark Nah da Larr

Monday December 27  
First part a fresh breeze from the S.W. and squally middle part from the S.E. and squally later part from E.S.E. and squally ship on port tack heading to the S. Cruising no observation

Tuesday December 28  
First part a strong breeze from E.S.E. ship on the port tack cruising middle part a heavy Gale from E.S.E. later part the same ship on the starboard tack heading E.N.E. Lat 36-55- Lon 156-58

Wednesday December 29  
First part a heavy Gale from the E.S.E. ship on the port tack middle part more moderate later part ship heading N.E. under double reefed topsail to a strong breeze and squally Lat 36-29 Lon 157-55

Thursday December 30  
Comes in with a strong Gale and a heavy sea from the S.W. at three P.M. came too under a close reefed main topsail on the port tack middle and later part a heavy Gale and squally Lat 36-28

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December 1  
Throughout this day a heavy Gale from S.W. with heavy S.W. ship on the port tack under a close reefed main topsail Lat 25-48

Saturday December 2  
Continues a heavy Gale from S.W. ship on the port tack under close reefed main topsail Lat 35-29 Lon 157-29

Sunday December 3  
First part more moderate more ship heading to the S.E. middle part the same later part main sail and stowed to the E. wind breaking at ten came too again on the starboard tack under close reefed main topsail blowing a heavy Gale from the S.W. Lat 29-43 Lon 158-29

Monday December 4  
First part a heavy Gale from the S.W. ship on the port tack under close reefed main topsail middle part more moderate later part a fresh breeze ship heading E. Cruising and a Whaling Bark to windward Lat 39-03 Lon 158-18
