Tuesday, Decem^r 8 First part a fresh breeze from SSW ship heading to the SE cruising middle part squally with thunder and lightning later part a strong breeze and squally from the SSW ship on the starboard tack Cruising Lat 37-55 Lon 163-55

Wednesday, Decem^r 9 A strong breeze from the S and S ship on the S. Starboard tack cruising at nine AM anchored the Flying Childs of Hobart Town got half ton potatoes from her Lat 35-33 Lon 161-5

Thursday, Decem^r 10 Brought this day fine weather and a light breeze from the SSW ship heading ENE Cruising Lat 35-57 Lon 161-25

Friday, Decem^r 11 Fine weather and a light breeze from the SE ship heading to the E Cruising the Flying Childs in sight to windward crew employed breaking out water Lat 35-42

in the South Pacific 1876

Saturday, Decem^r 12 First and middle part a light breeze from the S ship heading to the SE later part a fresh breeze and smoky ship Cruising Lat 35-22 Lon 163-39

Sunday, Decem^r 13 First and middle part a fresh breeze from the S ship heading to the SE later part a strong breeze from the S ship heading NNE Cruising Lat 34-31 Lon 165-15

Monday, Decem^r 14 Brought this day a strong breeze from the S ship on different tacks Cruising Lat 33-33 Lon 166-5

Tuesday, Decem^r 15 Continues a strong breeze from the S ship on the Port tack heading W Cruising Lat 33-35 Lon 169-21

Wednesday, Decem^r 16 First part a fresh breeze from the S ship heading to the W middle and later part moderate S by in light a storm more around and heeled for her Lat 33-33
