Friday Decem 22
Through this day a fresh
breeze from the NW and smoky
weather ship heading SSE
all sail set - Crew employed
rearing new running rigging
Lat 42 15

Saturday Decem 23
First part wind
hauling to the W middle
part fresh with squalls
later part a strong gale
close reefed the topsails
Ship heading SSE
Lat 44 29
Lon 165-10

Sunday Decem 24
This day a strong
gale and squally from the W
Ship heading SSE close reef
topsails
Lat 45 11

Monday Decem 25
First part a fresh
breeze from the NW ship heading
SSE sighted the land
middle part the same
later part a fresh breeze from
the W and squally gale
seven AM rose Salaruta
Rock cleared in for it

passage to Salaruta 1876

Tuesday Decem 26
Comes in with a
strong breeze and smoky from
the NW close reefed the topsails
the Rock bearing ESE dist 20 N
middle and later part a strong
breeze the Tamerlane in sight to
leeward

Wednesday Decem 26
Through this day a strong gale
from the NW ship on distant
tacks, cruising the Rock in
sight dist 20 N

Thursday Decem 27
Comes in with
a fresh breeze from the NW spoke
the Tamerlane wind increases
middle part blowing a terrific
gale lost the Bow Boat and
split the main topsail
broke out and bent a new one
later part fine from the W

Friday Decem 28
Light huffling
winds and clear cast the
Tamerlane in sight
Lat 47 11

Saturday Decem 29
First part a light
breeze from the E ship heading
NNE gained the Tamerlane
middle part light heading
NNE later part a light breeze
from the NW broke out water
at nine AM rose from Whales
coared three boats the Rock bearing ESE
dist 25 N
