Port William at ten & come
to with starboard anchor
at Port William

Wednesday Jan 10
Ship came at
Port William a strong Gale
and squally from the NW
and landed with a
raft of water

Thursday Jan 11
Fine weather
and a light breeze from the N
at seven PM got under way
and went around to both
moon Bay at nine came
to at Half moon Bay

Friday Jan 12
Fine weather at
ten & got under way with
a light breeze from the SE and
stood out to the East
Saw the Bark Splendid going
at Port William

Passage up the East side of

Saturday Jan 13

Light Breeze
Dunderd from E to SE Ship
on different tacks the land
in sight to the NW

Sunday Jan 14

Throught this
day light breeze Dunderd
from the E Ship on different
tacks land in sight
Lat 47-7

Monday Jan 15

Throught this day
moderate breeze from E to ESE
Ship on different tack later part
took in sail Ship on the port
tack heading SSE a thick fog

Tuesday Jan 16

Continues a moderate
breeze and thick fog Ship on
different tacks under short sail

Wednesday Jan 17

Throught this day
a thick fog and a light breeze
from the ESE Ship on different
tacks

Thursday Jan 18

First and middle
part a light breeze and thick
fog Ship under short sail
later part a moderate breeze
from the SE made all
sail and cleared SESE
