Sunday Jan 22. First and middle part a fresh breeze from the S. Later part wind hauled to the SW. Made all sail steared N.

Lon 179-20 E

Tuesday Jan 23. First part a strong gale from the SW ship heading S. all sail set. Middle part more moderate later part thick overcast from the S. Shortened sail. This day ends with a strong gale from the S.W. Ship under close reef main topsail.
Lat 33-9

Wednesday Jan 24. First a strong gale from the S. Ship under close reef main topsail on the Starboard tack heading W. Middle part wind hauled to the SW a heavy squall with thunder and lightning. Late part more ship and set. Under close reef topsails kepting S.W. This day ends with heavy squall from the N.W. Drove ship and hove to on the Starboard tack heading W.

Thursday Jan 25. First part ship lying under close reef main topsail. Middle part wind hauled to the W.S.W. at day light steared to the S. This day ends with a strong breeze from the W.S.W. no observations.
