

Arrived of Cape Horn May 13th

Friday May 11
First part a fresh breeze and
breezy weather, at eight P.M. I set a close reef
to the E. tried to keep company
until morning to get his longhairs
huddle part and hauled to the NW
a strong gale and squally lost part
of the ship at two P.M. came to under
a close reef main topsail heading
NE, so ends this day a heavy Gale from
the N ship going under a close reef main
topsail to Pserochones

Saturday May 12
At twelve noon I set
hailed to the SW at four P.M. set
the lee claw of the foresail and hauled
EVE at eight P.M. came to again under
a close reef main topsail huddle
part a heavy Gale from the SW
becompter hauled to 28.25 at day
light seven P.M. moderated I did
hailed to the W set a close reef
fore topsail and foresail and
shaved of EVE came on heavy squ
alls so took in sail and came
to again on the starboard tack head
ing I do ends this day Lat 37-50
Long 71-00

Sunday May 13
First part a strong from
WSW Gale with heavy squalls
at twelve noon kept on under
a close reef main topsail
and hauled NE huddle part the
same later part moderate made
all sail and a number of ships
spoke and hauled a French ship
Lein got his longhairs fourth
ours Port this day ends moderate
from the NW ship heading NE
Lat 38-13 Long 57-50

Monday May 14
First part a fresh breeze
from the N at 84 P.M. I set
to the NE clouded reefed the topsails
at midnight and hauled to the
W made sail and shaved 84 N
later part a moderate breeze from
the SW Lat 38-25
Long 63-14

Tuesday May 15
First part a moderate breeze
from the SW ship heading NE all sail set
huddle part the same later part and hauled
to the SW a light breeze ship heading NE
ends the same Lat 38-30
Long 63-14

Wednesday May 16
Comes in with a light
breeze from the NE ship on the port
ship heading NE and E at eight P.M.
I set up from the SW
huddle and later part a strong
breeze from SW carrying all sails
during NE passed three ships
clearing the same Lat 38-40
Long 67-40

Thursday May 17
First part a strong breeze
from the SW ship heading NE all sail
set huddle part moderate I did
hailed to the W later part and
hailed to the NW ship on the port
heading NE Lat 38-52
Long 63-00

Friday May 18th
Comes in with a strong
breeze and thick weather from the N
X Shalened sail heading NE at four
P.M. close reefed the topsails
huddle part the same later part
and hauled to the W made sail
and shaved 84 N Lat 38-35
Long 62-39
