Through this day a strong breeze and squally from the WNW ship heading NE Lat 47-38 Lon 150-7

Sunday May 20

Continues a strong breeze from WNW and squally ship under double reef topsails and courses of the wind heading NE Lat 48-20 Lon 150-00

Monday May 21

First part a strong breeze and squally from the WNW middle part squally close reefed ship heading from NE to E later part light squally crew employed getting out provisions and water Lat 49-20 Lon 151-30

Tuesday May 22

First part a light air from the N middle part a light breeze from the SE later part a fresh breeze from the SE sent up the main royal yard and set the royal Lat 49-53 Lon 152-15

Wednesday May 23

Through this day a strong breeze from the S ship heading ENE all sail set Lat 49-17 Lon 153-00

Thursday May 24

First and middle part a fresh breeze from the S later part wind hauled to the W doubled reefed the topsails ship heading ENE Lat 49-07 Lon 153-52

Friday May 25

First part a strong breeze and squally from the W ship under double reef topsails and courses middle part close reefed the main sail ship heading NE Lat 49-17 Lon 154-50

Saturday May 26

Through this day a strong breeze from the W all sail set heading ENE Lat 51-30 Lon 155-29

Sunday May 27

Fine weather and a strong breeze from the W ship heading NE all sail set Lat 52-28 Lon 156-20

Monday May 28

Through this day fine light weather from the S Lat out a boat and put her on the larboard cranes and manded the mast heads Lat 52-00 Lon 157-50

Tuesday May 29

Continues fine from the S ship heading NE all sail set crew employed fitting the rigging Lat 52-49 Lon 158-50

Wednesday May 30

Through this day fine weather and a moderate breeze from the S ship heading NE all sail set crew employed fitting the rigging Lat 54-1 Lon 159-19
