Thursday June 14

First part a moderate breeze from the ESE ship heading NNE all sail set at six PM took on light sails and hauled a back not share of position to pass the barolase reef. Thought the night squally hailing winds at day light made sail and cleared N this day ends with a fresh breeze from the SSE

Thought this day a moderate breeze from the SSE ship heading NNE all sail set

Thought this day a moderate breeze from the SSE at ten PM crossed the Equator ship heading NNE crew employed fitting

A moderate breeze from the SE to S with rain squalls ship heading from NNE to NE

Continued light hailing with rain from the SE no observation

Tuesday June 19

Thought this day a moderate breeze from the SSE with rain squalls ship heading NNE

Wednesday June 20

First part moderate breeze from the SSE ship heading NNE later part calm crew employed clearing the muddles

First part fine with a light air from the E crew employed cleaning the muddles and painting it middle part light later part a light breeze with heavy rain squalls no observations

Thought this day a fresh breeze with rain squalls crew employed cleaning topsails sheets & runners ship heading NNE Lat 9-09 Lon 40-18
