

1878 Remarks On board Bark Intella Lewis

Friday Feb 1st Had 37.30 Load

Loss 75.55 Hunt

Common cet with strong Bragg (from S. East
To N. by West) wind ship at two leagues from
I went to N. E. South with whole power
Fair sail, I reduced Fore & Courses jib & I hauled
Red shortened sail at sundown one sail &
Sulphur bottoms seen on the water a ship
at 12 alading & I cast later
Bragg from South heading & I sail with
Double reduced topsails & Fore sail at Sulphur
Bottoms seen

Saturday Feb. 2nd the opening

Saturday Dec. 22nd 1850
Calm as with strong breeze, 10 to 12
miles from South heading E. I sail with
Double reefed Topsails & are sail set at 5
Miles a half heading W. I went aboard when
Look on the Holesail on sail & I sighted
Bottoms seen middle heading 1/2 I was
to after fresh bustling winds with rain squalls
from South to I went wore ship at 2 heading
from I went to West with whole Topsails &
Courses set saw one sail

Sunday Feb 3rd Lat 32° 35' Long 75° 21' West

Le m 25: 21/10/18

Commences with strong Breeze from
South, blowing from East to E by East under
Double reefed Topsails & Courses full & spindling
Set of jibs, & sail of sun down now full &
Pusher bottoms seen on 14th at 11
4 Miles latter turning Breeze from S by East
heading of Wind more shift, at 2 heading
East by South reefs and mainsail & top sail
set & spindling & Courses and two sail.
A Pusher bottoms seen

Cruising off Chilli-

Monday Feb 4th 1840

Long 75.106 West

Commenced with strong Breeze from S. S. E. ship steering from E. N. E. by to N. N. E. with whole main Toppail & double reefed & set & courses set. spoke the hantaras two other ship in sight & shortly sail at our stern. And soon sail heading S. W. & mid way between E. & N. E. entering near Bridge from S. W. the ship at S. heading E. S. E. & a gunnery shot the hantaras and other sail & ship in Boston's Green

Tuesday Feb 5th Lat 27. 45 South
Long 15. 01 West

Less 25.01 Nov

Commenced with strong breeze from South
during early, with slight fresh Sapsails
& Loons, & called to the birds at 6.
Heaving E. G. East - arrived with the hantulus
sporting sail at sundown & were sail.
Heaving S. P. West one sail & further to be
seen night heaving & West latter strong
breeze from S. G. East heaving & West
with cloudy fresh Sapsails, 1000 main
& 1000 Sapsails to the hantulus, two
other sail seen

Wednesday Feb 6th Lat 32. 31 Long 78

Leon 13⁵⁴, Mei

commenced with strong Breeze from S of East, drove ship at 1 PM making East with double reefed Topsails & fore from & making 14 knots and at 2 PM raised anchor & went to sea for the ship coming to the windward Got the B. out down but he went down ship for the ship lowering the waist B. lower had died and we saw him after words the knuckles in sight and he came ship at 12 making 14 knots & took in fore & top sail better strong breeze went 18 knots making 14 knots and fore & top sail close reefed the knuckles in sight
