

878 Remarks on board Bark Intrepid

Tuesday May 14th Lat 33° 15' N Long 81° 15' W

Commenced with fresh breeze from East
Went ship at 1 heading S E and went with
Bark Intrepid 3 other sail in sight shortened
sail and ran down middle heading S E and
later fresh breeze from E S E and went ship
at 2 going with the Capt from Pigeon
Stations one other sail seen

Wednesday May 15th No Observations
Commenced with light winds from E S E
heading North West sail seen shortened
sail and ran down middle the same later
light breeze from E S E heading North West
Went the Intrepid saw 2 humpbacks employed
in breaking out water

Thursday May 16th Lat 33° 35' N Long 81° 26' W
Commenced with light breeze from East
heading S E and went ship at 1 middle
wind headed to S E and later light winds
from S E and heading East at 2 saw the Mary
Susan & Pantaloon whaling and lowered our boats
The Intrepid lowered his & chased off whalers
going quick to N West

Friday May 17th No Observations
Commenced with light winds from East to S E
East Boats in pursuit of the whaler at 2 went
them up and the Boats up at lower Masafura
In sight bearing E S E and by compass N N E
heading North later fresh breeze from N N West
went ship at 10 heading S West four
sail in sight & Masafura bearing E S E
By compass

Cruising Off Masafura

Saturday May 18th No Observations
Commenced with fresh
breeze from N N West heading S West took in
the light sail and ran down joined with the
Intrepid & Mary Susan and all went ship at
1 heading N N West later fresh breeze from N
N West went ship at 10 heading S West
three sail in sight

Sunday May 19th Lat 33° 15' N Long 81° 15' W
Commenced with strong winds from N
N West to S S West went ship at 10 heading
N N West to West shortened sail at
saw three sail seen & humpbacks 2
heading East later fresh breeze from S E
heading East one sail & humpbacks seen

Monday May 20th Lat 33° 15' N Long 81° 22' W
Commenced with light winds from
S E and to E S E at 4 went ship heading S E and
headed with the Mary Susan the land being East
took in the light sail and ran down middle heading
later light winds from East went ship at 2 and
humpbacks & Blackfish the Mary Susan &
the land in sight set taught the Bapsdups
found the eyeballs nearly all off but saw one
in one of them & lashed the other one with rope

Tuesday May 21st Lat 33° 10' N Long 81° 00' W
Commenced with light winds from
N West heading N S West with all sail at shortened sail
at ran down enlarged in stay of the head gear
The Mary Susan & Pantaloon went ship at 10
saw heading N N West later fresh breeze
from N N West went ship at 10 heading
West three sail & humpbacks seen joined
with the Bark Jack howland
