

1878 Remarks On Board Bark Matilda Sears

Monday Sept 30th Lat 35° 45' S Lon 144° 49' W
Commenced with fresh Breeze from South
Storing by South shifted by the wind at
last heading. S. East shortened sail at
Sun down. Giving (with) the vessel in all
port ship at 12 heading N. East latter fresh
Breeze from South Storing North at 11 1/2
headed to S. East the Mauties in sight

Tuesday Oct 1st Lat 35° 48' S Lon 143° 32' W
Commenced with fresh Breeze from South
Storing by East at 8 1/2 were ship
heading N. East shortened sail at sun down
got at Cork of Breeze from the Mauties
308 galleys packed saw three ships in all
heading N. East latter fresh Breeze from
South Storing N. East employed in
making sail with the Mauties & three other
sail in sight

Wednesday Oct 2nd Lat 35° 05' S Lon 146° 09' W
Commenced with fresh Breeze South heading
N. East tacked at 3 heading S. East shortened
sail at sun down 3 sail in sight middle
heading S. East latter fresh Breeze from South
at 7 tacked heading N. East two sail seen

Thursday Oct 3rd Lat 35° 32' S Lon 148° 11' W
Commenced with light Breeze from S. East
Storing by South at sun down took in the
light sails shifted to the wind heading S
East gave with the Leucetia middle vessel
ship at 12 heading North N. East latter light
air from S. East Storing S. East the Leucetia &
one other sail in sight saw Humphreys

Cruising Off Chile

Friday Oct 4th Lat 35° 52' S Lon 151° 44' W
Commenced with light Breeze from S. East
Ship at 4 1/2 heading N. East at 4 lowered for
Blackish the Wind Boat struck gun & the one of
the irons and at 6 got aboard at sun down took
in the light sails one sail in sight middle
Calm latter light air from S. East Storing N
East North employed in securing the Leucetia
& painting them the Leucetia in sight saw Humphreys

Saturday Oct 5th Lat 35° 40' S Lon 150° 08' W
Commenced with light Breeze from S. East Storing
N. East with all sail at 12, at 12 securing
the iron work outside & painting it at sun down
took in the light sails & shifted to the wind
Heading N. East middle vessel were ship at 12 heading
S. East latter light Breeze from S. East with
quite thick foggy ship heading S. East by compass
one sail seen

Sunday Oct 6th Lat 35° 34' S Lon 148° 51' W
Commenced with light Breeze from S. East
With fog heading S. East shortened sail
at sun down the Leucetia in sight in S. E
were ship at 12 heading N. East latter calm
two sail in sight

Monday Oct 7th Lat 35° 48' S Lon 146° 27' W
Commenced with light Breeze from S. East
were ship at 4 heading S. East middle heading
N. East latter fresh Breeze from South
heading S. East 3 sail in sight

Tuesday Oct 8th Lat 35° 44' S Lon 144° 35' W
Commenced with fresh Breeze from South at
4 tacked heading N. East gave with the Standard
& other sail own shortened sail at sun down one sail
heading N. East latter strong Breeze from South
were ship at 7 heading S. East the Standard &
Susan in sight saw Humphreys
