Friday Oct 18th Lat 36° 03' South Lon 74° 34' West
Commences with light breeze from S.W. to
S. South at 2 1/2 and 3 1/2 heading W. & W. S. W.
Shortened sail at sundown the Stamboul
seen in sight saw humpbacks 1. 1. 1. heading
W. & W. S. W. later fresh breeze from S. & W. S. W.
Sailed with at 10 light to the wind heading
S. & E. the Stamboul in sight saw humpbacks

Saturday Oct 19th Lat 36° 00' S Lon 74° 30' West
Commences with fresh breeze from S. & W. S. W.
More ship at 3 heading W. S. W. and all sail set
At sundown shortened sail one sail & humpback
seen middle were ship at one heading S. & E. S. E.
Latter fresh breeze from South heading S. & E. S. E.
Employed in breaking and back & back & water
not anything seen

Sunday Oct 20th Lat 35° 41' S Lon 75° 02' West
Commences with fresh breeze from South
heading S. & E. S. E. shortened sail at sundown
I was ship heading W. S. W. and one sail seen
Middle wind hauled to W. S. W. and one ship
At heading S. W. S. W. latter fresh breeze from
W. S. W. heading S. W. S. W. the Stamboul in sight

Monday Oct 21st No Observations
Commences with strong wind & thick weather
from W. S. W. heading S. W. S. W. at 4 1/2 and 5
hauled to S. & W. S. W. and one ship heading
S. W. S. W. shortened sail at sundown
the Stamboul in sight saw humpbacks
At one heading S. & E. S. E. latter light breeze
from South heading S. & E. S. E. three
sail in sight

Commences with light breeze from S. & E. S. E.
More ship at 2 heading W. S. W. and one
ship the Stamboul water sailing sight
Middle were ship at 2 heading S. & E. S. E. latter
Fresh winds from S. & W. S. W. to W. S. W. heading
from S. & E. S. E. to South two sail seen

Wednesday Oct 23rd Lat 36° 15' South Lon 74° 15' West
Commences with strong breeze from W. S. W. S. W.
To that heading from South to S. & W. S. W.
Shortened sail at sundown two sail seen
Middle wind hauled to South and one ship at
two heading W. S. W. S. W. latter light breeze
from South heading W. S. W. S. W. & sail seen

Thursday Oct 24th No Observations
Commences with calm foggy & sp. 1/2
Short sail & humpbacks seen middle were ship
W. S. W. heading S. & W. S. W. latter fresh breeze from
W. S. W. and one ship at 10 heading S. & W. S. W.
Sail in sight the Stamboul & humpbacks

Friday Oct 25th Lat 36° 17' South Lon 74° 23' West
Commences with fresh breeze from W. S. W. S. W.
two Breeze on and hauled to S. & W. S. W. and
ship at 6 heading W. S. W. S. W. three reefed the
topsails gamed with the humpbacks & Susan
middle heading S. & E. S. E. latter strong breeze from
S. & W. S. W. to S. & E. S. E. and one ship at 10 heading
S. & E. S. E. the humpbacks & Susan in sight

Saturday Oct 26th Lat 36° 10' South Lon 74° 45' West
Commences with strong breeze from S. & E. S. E. heading
S. & E. S. E. at sundown were ship & shortened the
topsails & furled the foresail over the Susan
middle heading S. & W. S. W. latter strong breeze
from S. & E. S. E. heading S. & W. S. W. with three
Reefed topsails & lower yards of the Susan
for sight
