Remarks On board Bark. Matthew Sears

Sunday April 28th Lat 33⁴² & Long 78²² Went
Lizard past station of Brazil from S Head steering
for the Island of Pelam at 4 headed of which
the Capt^d went on shore to engage some wood
at 5 got onboard againe reluffed the Topsails &
look in fish & Spunker reaching C. H. Head
one sail in sight middle being off Voss
from latter steering Brazil from S Head lying
off & on the Island how struggled to get at
Wood the Land^r & exploded alloo searching
for Wood

Tuesday April 19th Laying off on
the Island of Juan with three Breeks from
I. & A. with the Lunar & Chronology & Sextant
but it being so reggled could not get
off any water found the Chronometer 20
Minutes to the East of the ship middle &
latter the same

Wednesday April 30th. Lord had
laying off 4 on the Island of Pass with
strong Breeze from SE had waiting for it the
Moderate so we can get round about also the
Lionar Napoleon & Lucrilia middle laying off
4 on latter strong Breeze from SE had
laying off 4 on the 1st at 8 the Capt went on shore
the 2nd about the wind at 10 1/2 got off land
of wind I sent her in again for more wood

Thurs Day May 1st Lived hard fresh
Brought down I went buying off & on from good
at launch built at about 8 tons and back
again at 2 1/2 and 2. The seaman Andrew
of Lumber did after a short illness of three
days called at the Surgery built off & on
on better light air from Smith off the ship
to get up so as to leave the man Cooper employed
in making a Coffin for the Corps

Friday May 2nd
from South working up to the Island as to
bury the men put down in the Coffin the Generals
& Loucretia & Napoleon in right middle cabin
latter light Breeze from S West stood in, to the
barn at 6. The Boat started Shore with the
Corps to Bury it

Saturday May 3rd. To port port light
Breeze from S. East blowing off & on from the
Capt ashore bringing the Moon at 4 got on
board & started at 1/2 P. M. the Lunar & Locomotive
getting moved with the steering 1/2 P. M. latter part
Breeze from South steamer at West employed in
ships duty but on nothing seen.

June 4 day May 19th. No Observations
 Found fresh Bruch from South shore &
 2 M.D. and nothing seen birds entering
 2 B. Red better than Bruch from South shore
 1/2 M.D. with all sail did saw A. Lillie Bottom

From Long Mary 5th Dec 31st 25th Easted Line 19th 42nd
 First part light Bragg from S. E. Eastward
 A 4th Wind with all sail set and everything well
 Middle turning 4th Wind rather fresh Bragg from
 S. East returning 4th Wind with all sail set
 employed in ship duty and everything well
