

1879 Remarks On Sourd Bark on the Sears

Tuesday Aug 19th

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Found good light breeze from S. S. West
beating in shore at sundown backed up
short West head Bering & I had 10 miles off
finished the Lowsalt & bent it to Sea port
& Leucatia in sight Wind was now shift at
12 latter light breeze from South steering N. E. East
with head bearing land went down the main
Topsail & bent another the Sea port & Leucatia
in sight

Wednesday Aug 27th

Commences with light breeze from South
morning N. E. E. employed in repairing
Main Top at which time observed
the Rock Bearing N. E. E. No Lacerta
of Sea not in sight in 4th hour
light breeze from South morning N. E. E.

Thursday Aug 21st

Commenced with fresh Breeze fresh South
sterning N. E. and the Rock Breeze E. N. E. and
employed in ships during the forenoon in
reg'd incidentally better light Breeze from
South sterning N. E. and Rock Breeze N. E.
and the Sea, fog & Leindig Shew'd in with

Friday Aug 22nd

commenced with fresh Breeze from South
steering N by East The Barck Bearing N East
gained with the Lee was steered for Sea
port luffed to the wind at 5 miles off
shore the hills were still better light Breeze from
South steering N East The Landing Stead & Surfer in 20

Saturday Aug 23rd

Commences with fresh breeze from South evening
H. & L. boat tipped to the wind making us feel
air to begin good stroke at our better row
punches after steering H. & L. boat The Boat
bearing a boat employed in breaking and mending the Schoon

Leaving Off the Redonda Rock

San Aug Aug 24th

Sanchez Aug 24th
Commences with light breeze from S. West
turning E. & E. by N. off our bows, backed to the
wind & hauled off short with main & fore
sprack the back Bearing E. & E. by N. the Sea
not in sight 'til about 4 o'clock. Latter
light breeze from S. West heading I could
~~not see the land~~ the foremast reefed & the
foremast told him to get to his anchor
the Sea not in sight our foremast.

Sunday Aug 25th

Monday Aug 25th
Commencing with light breeze from
South heading & I had spoked perhaps
the back Breezy & I had middle heading
& I had latter light breeze from S. I had
heading & I had employed in ship's duties
The 2nd Mate Mr. Worth had some trouble
with one of the Boatstewards had some words
with the Captain refused duty went to
his room the Sea got in a light sea fair

Tues Aug. Aug 26th

Commenced with light Breeze from S. S. West heading S. E. but with strong current setting to the West saw Limbacks as the Sea got in sight at sundown the Rocks being 4 to 5 by 5 miles N. W. by light Breeze latter light Breeze from S. S. East heading S. West saw Limbacks the Sea got in sight

Medico Bay. Aug 27th

Medusa Bay. Aug 28th
Commenced with light breeze from S. S. Wood
heaving S. but more ship at 5 P. heaving
North. The Bark Bearing N. N. East. The Sea Fox
sight 2 or 3 miles back middle heaving E. S. East
latter light breeze from South steering North
employed in ship during the Sea Fox in sight
