

1879 Remarks On board Bark Matilda Lewis

Friday Oct 3rd Tied last strong
Breeze from S.W. heading S.E. and
Crew employed in repairing oil casks
The boat in sight the little backed
ship at 3 latter light Breeze from S.
Wind heading S.E. with all sail
at 8 o'clock repairing oil casks sighted
the Island of Platta bearing S.E. and

Saturday Oct 4th Commenced
with light Breeze from S.W. and
heading S.E. at sundown the
Island of Platta bearing S.E. 15 miles
off middle heading S.E. latter light
Breeze from S.W. tucked ship at
7 1/2 heading N.W. Wind employed in
painting the ship inside the fore plus
the land in sight S.W. Breeze

Sunday Oct 5th Commenced with
light Breeze from S.W. tucked ship
at 3 heading N.W. and at sundown
Capt. S. H. Boring Sailed in light
Breeze at 12 heading S.E. latter
light Breeze from S.W. heading S.E. and
the land in sight

Monday Oct 6th Commenced with
light Breeze from S.W. steering S.
and at 3 o'clock sighted at 12 miles off
the light bearing S.E. and
H. were ship & headed off about middle
were ship at 12 latter light Breeze from
S.W. steering S.W. and at 1 o'clock
in sight



Logging in Tumbell

Tuesday Oct 7th Commenced with
light Breeze from S.W. steering S.E. and
at 4 o'clock the anchor off Tumbell in
12 fathoms of water the Tumbell Bark
in sight latter light Breeze from S.W.
and at 8 o'clock employed in painting the
ship inside

Wednesday Oct 8th
Commenced with light Breeze from S.W. and
employed in painting ship at 5 the Capt.
went on board latter the Capt.
went ashore employed in painting

Thursday Oct 9th Commenced with
light Breeze from S.W. at five the
Capt. got on board latter light Breeze
from S.W. tucked the ship in near the
land broke out Breeze Port

Friday Oct 10th Commenced with
light Breeze from S.W. employed in
burning the boats latter light Breeze from
S.W. took on board two dead heads & potatoes

Saturday Oct 11th Commenced with
fresh Breeze from S.W. working for the potatoes
to be fresh Breeze from S.W. got another Boat
load of potatoes the Capt. went ashore

Sunday Oct 12th Commenced with fresh
Breeze from S.W. at 6 the Capt. got on
board with the remainder of the potatoes
middle at four got under weigh latter
light Breeze from S.W. and at 1 o'clock
steering S.W. from S. steering S.W. and
the anchor & well down the Capt.
