

1880 Remarks on Board Boat Matilda Lewis

Tuesday June 8th Lat 42° 25' Long 34° 38' West
 First part light breeze from South steering
 N by E and Cape Blanco bearing East at distance
 15 miles off and up the Gutierrez falls and
 high rocks. The steering N by E and better
 light breeze from West steering N by E by
 East at 10 o'clock the Island of St. Clara
 bearing N by E and suffered in ship.
 during the Captain no better

Wednesday June 9th First part light
 breeze from West steering for anchorage
 got the cables up & 2 anchors off the bow
 at 7 o'clock the anchor in 12 fathoms
 of water. Reeling in and on shore better
 at daylight I walked with the Boat
 for the town to get a doctor to
 come & see the Captain

Thursday June 10th First part fresh
 breeze from the West at 2 1/2 p.m. got
 on board with the doctor the Captain
 no better while the doctor on board
 later went on shore for to get some
 medicine the Captain no better

Friday June 11th First part fresh
 breeze from from the West at 3 p.m.
 got on board with the doctor on board better
 the Captain no better the doctor still on
 board the Captain of the port came on board
 took on shore two of the ship papers

Saturday June 12th First part ship still
 at anchor the Captain no better the doctor
 still on board better the same employed
 in breaking out water later the doctor
 still on board

Sunday June 13th First part still dropping
 at anchor the doctor still on board the better
 the same the Captain at little better

Monday June 14th First part still at anchor
 the doctor still on board better the same

Tuesday June 15th First part ship still at anchor
 the doctor still on board the Captain improving
 later the same went on shore to get some chickens

Wednesday June 16th First part still at anchor
 the doctor still on board the Captain going
 better the same

Thursday June 17th First part ship still at
 anchor the doctor still on board better the
 same

Friday June 18th First part ship
 at anchor doctor on board the Captain
 improving better the same

Saturday June 19th First part light
 breeze from West the ship still at anchor
 the doctor still on board the Captain
 improving better the same the Boat went on shore

Sunday June 20th First part the ship still at
 anchor the doctor still on board at 3 1/2 p.m. got
 on board better the same

Monday June 21st First part fine weather
 fresh breeze from West ship still at anchor
 better the same

Tuesday June 22nd First part fresh breeze
 from West going at anchor the doctor
 still on board better the same
