

SS. Hemlock On Sand Bar Middle River

Sunday July 4th First part light breeze
from S.W. & steering for the Island of Oregan.
at 4 P.M. came to anchor in 35 fathoms of
water & 3 finished putting the little boy in
the anchor latter went on shore to get food
& catch Iron fish

Sunday July 5th Hunt put eight Brays
from West's lot on the Snare & started
to by West fell in with a porvian Bray shot
of porvian let him have some mchls.
turning to by West better fresh Brays from
East's lot I went steering to by West and anything used

Sunday July 6th 1842 23 Part Clear & cool but
 a little wind fresh breeze from West steering
 by the N. with all sail set employed in
 ship daily and everything else neatly done
 by the latter fresh breeze from S. West and
 N. W. with rain during the wind employed
 in steering down the oil over the land

Wednesday July 27th Lat 6¹/₄ N Long 84¹/₄ W
Commenced with fresh breeze from S.W. &
to Mod steering N.W. at 6 hauled the N.W.
ward wore ship at 8 finished steering down
the rib. The ship got a breeze from S.W. & steered
to Mod better light breeze from S.W. &
steering N.W. & the land in sight

Thursday July 3rd Lat 22° 20' North Lon. 85° 07' West
Commenced workd light Buryl from W. S. M. at
to W. H. H. D. also long fence to W. H. D. to W. H. D.
under the main sail I started to survey
the W. H. D. & Buryl from I. L. at started to
W. H. D. righted the fore sails to employ
in ship duty

Hambocking in Panama Bay

Friday July 1st 1880. Wind port light breeze from
N. E. The S. E. and steering N. W. by W. the four
Islands bearing E. N. E. and hummocks & the
roughly patch the good rope to burn. To sail
but the light breeze from North heading N. W. by W.
and down the main to sail to the pier.

 Saturday July 10th Finest perfect light
 Breeze from NW. All 4 men tied at
 the Lahn saw one sail Middle reaching
 1/2d better light Breeze from West drove in the
 the wind in port. But shortly hauled around
 and lowered the Boats The L.B. at struck one
 I sawed then the W Boat struck one I sawed
 him at 10/11 got him along side at 12 dropped
 the anchor

Sunday July 11th
 Kind put at Spoked out in the whale
 I cut at the Baker put six net the swatches
 I started the works Mitchell Boiling better of
 Bragg with a in. & so I managed get under
 weight I covered 3 but the 4th we struck a
 1st and him along side I got dinner
 supper in boiling

Monday July 12th Frost part out on the
whole I cut 2 of the Bkbr still putting
little bushes other 4 got the ship under way
I lowered the Bkbr struck a whale I saw
him finished Bkbr at 12

Tuesday July 13th First frost at 2 yet
the actual storm with cold here in I said the
Matches for the night Middle end of the block
I started the works better yet sun by way I lowered
the boats were here high but could not get
over the thin
