

1886 Remarks On Board Bark Mitchell. I was

Wednesday Sept 28th First put
got out and the remainder of the night
I put it in the launch & it went
up to the town latter employed in
storing some corks in the ground.

Thursday Sept 29th First put
laying in Panama waiting for work
from shore later on got in laying
up corks

Friday Sept 30th
First put got laying in Panama got
out and with the crew laid out
some corks latter had a launch of
mild corks & B&P & Cork took them
on board & stored away the B&P &
Cork & commenced the rest of the corks
and two men & two boys on shore
to ship.

Saturday Sept 30th
First put employed in setting up
corks the work men went up & out
by the key, Sept 1 the crew were not
latter employed in setting up corks
storing the corks the two men
went on shore again & stored corks
& Manuel

Sunday Sept 30th
First put employed in setting
up corks & storing the corks latter

Monday Sept 30th First put laying
in Panama latter employed in setting
up corks

Tuesday Sept 30th
First put laying in Panama employed
in setting up corks latter the crew
and the cork shore to be discharged

Wednesday Sept 29th First put laying
in Panama employed in setting
corks & storing the corks latter the crew

Thursday Sept 30th First put employed
in setting up corks waiting for
another latter finished setting up corks

Friday Oct 1st First put laying
in Panama waiting for matter latter
the same

Saturday Oct 2nd
First put laying in Panama all
ready for sea waiting for matter
latter the same

Sunday Oct 3rd
First put laying in Panama at 6
the water had come along side took
over another latter all ready for sea
waiting for matter

Monday Oct 4th
First put laying in Panama the
last crew on board had gone latter
at daylight took the anchor & started
and with light breeze and the main sail

Tuesday Oct 5th First put fresh breeze
from S & E with rain squalls at 4 PM
got at rain squall & backed the main
& put the mast gradually latter fresh breeze
from N & E with heavy S.W. at 10 I saw
main top sail the Cape Horn in sight

Wednesday Oct 6th First put fresh
breeze from S & E with backing & bed
with all sail at the Cape Horn in
sight middle trading & at latter light
breeze from S & E with backing & E end with
all sail at 10 saw nothing new
