

1880 Remarks On board Bark Mutilda. Tues

Thursday Nov 1st Lat 42° 2' South Lon 148° 1' W. at
First light sight Bruehl from S. S. East
went down the river I must stay until
I report it. The first in sight middle
hearing S. S. West better fresh Bruehl from
S. East heading S. S. West tucked at 10
the land in sight employed in ship duty

Friday Nov 2nd Lat 42° 2' South Lon 148° 1' W. at
Sight Bruehl from S. S. East heading S. S. West
Poyta hull bearing S. S. East heading S. S. West
coming off & on Poyta better light
Bruehl from S. East heading off & on
Poyta the Capt sent to shore

Saturday Nov 3rd Lat 42° 2' South Lon 148° 1' W. at
Poyta at three the Capt. reached and
on board with his wife & little girl
headed off shore middle heading S. S. West
better light Bruehl from S. S. East heading
S. S. West employed in getting out water

Sunday Nov 4th Lat 42° 2' South Lon 148° 1' W. at
First light sight Bruehl from S. East heading S. S. West
employed in ship duty saw one sail turning to the
north middle heading S. S. West better light
Bruehl from S. East heading S. S. West

Monday Nov 5th Lat 42° 2' South Lon 148° 1' W. at
First light sight Bruehl from S. East heading
S. S. West with all sail set saw Humphreys
middle heading S. S. West better than Bruehl
from S. S. by S. East heading S. S. West sent
down the river sent to repair not any
thing seen

Tuesday Nov 6th Lat 42° 2' South Lon 148° 1' W. at
First light sight Bruehl from S. S. East heading
S. S. West employed in repairing
the main sail middle heading S. S. West
better fresh Bruehl from S. S. East heading
S. S. West at 8 1/2 raised upper whale going
to the South at 10 1/2 lower whale boats
lost one of them at 12

Wednesday Nov 7th Lat 42° 2' South Lon 148° 1' W. at
First light fresh Bruehl from S. S. East heading
S. S. West boats down did not see the whale
at 6 got on board middle heading S. S. West
better fresh Bruehl from S. East heading S. S. West
boats spotted the S. East at 9 raised upper
whale going quick to S. East lower
three boats whale melted more to seaward

Thursday Nov 8th Lat 42° 2' South Lon 148° 1' W. at
First light fresh Bruehl from S. East heading
S. S. West in view of the anchors going quick
to S. East at 5 went out off sight of the
boats gone then at 6 1/2 got on board
middle heading S. S. West at 12 better light Bruehl
from S. East S. S. West went down the river
stay & finished fuel - not anything seen

Friday Nov 9th Lat 42° 2' South Lon 148° 1' W. at
First light sight Bruehl from S. East heading
S. S. West went ship to anchor heading S. S. West
S. East employed in firing the major stay
middle heading S. S. West better light Bruehl
from S. S. East steering to West saw Salpeter
Boatmen put up to Major stay
