Tuesday Dec 14th Lat 11° 18' Long 81° 54' Wind
Wind fresh but breeze from S. S. East beating
boat employed in ship duty. The Lus are
in sight, i.e. reaching Co. R. D. better

Wednesday Dec 16th Left 11:00 AM for the 33rd West
Hill & put high 5. Bright sun & East hunting

 in ship study our Blackbirds & Gulls

Sunday Dec 14th The Observations
 First shot for a Wren's Egg. It was placed
 South the fusar in sight middle sea bird
 South (rather fresh) Bunch from E & S East
 reaching South with all sail set some Sulphur
 Bottoms the Sower in sight

Cruising for Sparrow Hawks

Mon day Dec 22^d 1845. S. D. Sun 80 & 40. Went
Commerce with John F. & his family & S. East
beating S. S. West with all sail and some
Sulphur Bottoms. Wind N. E. backing. Sea to latter
light breeze from E. S. E. & N. backing to N. E. & S.
gave a visit to the Bank for the S. & S. D.

Tus. Aug Dec 24th Na Observations
 Wind fresh light Breeze from S.E. & the sailing
 S.S. Boat going with the Lin. the Stewart &
 Mary & Susan with the speaking Sloop W.D. Luther
 fresh Breeze from S.E. by S. with the sailing Sloop W.D.

Reaches Bay Dec 22nd at 10.30 P.M. L.S. 1.44 and
found full fresh Bragg's gun S.P. and heading
and with all sail set. Several fishing boats
later fresh Bragg's heading S.P. and employed in
ship entry. The Susan in sight saw Links's

Thurs day Dec 23rd had 13455 South Len 8143 S. M. D
First part fresh tracks from E. S. East heading
South with all rail and now Timberacks Middle
part and 24th better fresh Brang from S. S
East heading East employed in treeing
and mowing some Timberacks

Friday Dec 14th @ Led/Bago Looked over 145th Regt
Lined up fresh troops from I S C and looking
good with all suit and some more suit. I
think the middle truck at 12 further fresh troops
from I S C and looking good truck at 12 employed
in ship duty over firebacks

Saturday Dec 25th 1841. 12 Cents per Sp^l 12th 1/2
A good part fresh Trades from I & C^t heading
E & C^t with all sail and the Sissors in sight
our Timberacks' middle Tack and the latter
fresh Breeze from I & C^t heading E & C^t
and nothing else.
