

1851 Remarks On Board Bark Antilla Sams

Friday Jan 28th Lat 53° 32' Long 26° 13' West
 First put fresh tracks from Iland
 steering West the heavy & low air in night
 steering the same at 3^{1/2} saw her light
 in the air & lower her boats ahead for
 her at 3^{1/2} lowered our boats her boats
 struck & afloat whales going by the light
 saw the whales from the ship first before
 under our light and all three out of the
 boats & all the crew at 1^{1/2} better fresh breeze
 from West steering N by West the crew
 in sight nothing

Saturday Jan 29th Lat 54° 4' Long 26° 32' West
 First put fresh tracks from Iland steering
 N by West kept in the air at 5 saw
 fresh tracks Middle heading S by West
 better and all at 6 heading E by South
 with strong breeze out anything seen

Sunday Jan 30th Lat 54° 48' Long 26° 31' West
 First put strong breeze from S by
 by South heading E by South and
 everything calm Middle heading S by West
 better light breeze from S by East heading
 S by West saw out and S by South by West

Monday Jan 31st Lat 55° 00' Long 27° 03' 4" West
 First put fresh tracks from S by East
 heading S by West with all sail and took
 in the light sail and under Middle
 heading the same better S by Breeze from
 S by East heading S by East

Tuesday Feb 1st Lat 55° 15' Long 27° 11' West
 First put strong breeze from S by East
 heading S by East took at anchor & took
 in light sail and all the crew at 3
 better strong breeze from S by East heading S by East
 at 4^{1/2} raised from anchor going to 4^{1/2} West

Wednesday Feb 2nd Lat 55° 50' Long 29° 14' West
 First put fresh tracks from Iland at our lower
 four boats for the whales the Le B put struck all
 four boats and put the Le B and G B put down
 took the other two along side while went to
 South Middle got ready for cutting better
 fresh breeze from Iland with heavy swell &
 cut in the whales and anything seen

Thursday Feb 3rd Lat 55° 40' Long 28° 42' West
 First put fresh tracks from Iland heading S by
 West cleared away the heads & started the
 crews gave fresh tracks in the heading S by West
 better fresh breeze from S by East went ship at
 7^{1/2} heading East employed in sailing

Friday Feb 4th Lat 55° 32' Long 29° 46' West
 First put fresh tracks from S by East
 heading East at 2^{1/2} raised from anchor
 went giving out and went round giving the
 South lowered three boats did not get
 away never then they were giving back
 employed in sailing & all finished sailing
 better light breeze from South heading N by West

Saturday Feb 5th Lat 55° 37' Long 27° 03' 4" West
 First put light breeze from S by East heading
 N by West Middle heading S by East better
 saw near calm stowed down the sail in
 the main hall saw Porpoises

Sunday Feb 6th Lat 55° 37' Long 27° 03' 4" West
 First put light breeze from S by East went
 ship at 4 heading S by East the whole crew
 better the same saw porpoises & Periwinkles
