

1881 Remarks On Board Bark Mutilda Sues

Tues day Mar 15th Lat 35° 14' Long 144° 35' W. at
Commenced with strong Breeze from South
heading N. E. W. D. wind still S. E. heating
S. E. D. with which S. winds & Breezes
and our Suffer Bottoms had some trouble
and one of the Boat steers Antonio Johnson
put him in runs mildly heating to
S. E. D. better calm took the water
and of Irons saw Sulfur buttons

Wednesday Mar 16th Lat 35° 41' N. Long 144° 00' W. at
Fair light calm at 5 got it Breeze from
S. W. D. started S. E. D. caught two
Sword fish 1. The heating & better
Calm lower for humpbacks struck
A Saw it fish & had him

Thursday Mar 17th Lat 35° 54' N. Long 143° 24' W. at
Fair light Breeze from S. W. D.
starting S. E. D. & getting the boat on
around the ship with all our humpbacks
& two with mild heating S. E. D.
better light Breeze from S. E. W. D. heating
S. E. D. got up the cables & anchors off
the Bow gunwale in sight

Friday Mar 18th Fair light Breeze
Breeze from S. E. W. D. passed gunwale
at 10 and at 5 1/2 went to anchor in
Fair light weather the crew all went
ashore employed in working ship getting
ready for painting the masts & Sues with

Saturday Mar 19th employed in painting
ship & getting ready to break and oil

Sunday Mar 20th one watch on shore
for liberty

Monday Mar 21st employed in breaking
and oil got out a deck load

Tuesday Mar 22nd employed in getting and
port oil loaded a bunch & took it to the masts
& Sues on ground and another deck load

Wednesday Mar 23rd employed took load of
oil to the masts & Sues on shore & the ground
in the main hatch & filled it with oil
another

Thursday Mar 24th employed
storing the main hold got a bunch
load of empty casks from the masts & Sues on

Friday Mar 25th breaking and oil in
the fore hold & stored the ground again on
one side

Saturday Mar 26th
took four casks all to the masts & Sues on
& filled the ground tier with oil another in
the fore hold

Sunday Mar 27th
one watch on liberty

Monday Mar 28th employed in breaking
oil & breaking and oil in the fore hold
& stored the ground tier one side

Tuesday Mar 29th employed in getting
and oil

Wednesday Mar 30th took
the load of oil to the masts & Sues on
all she could take

Thursday Mar 31st employed in getting oil
casks & storing them away
A. J. D. employed in getting Friday Mar 31st
up casks took about five casks & oil
back 26 lbs & 2 gals
