midnight & took in foresail & made
making S.W. with better strong breeze
from S.E. but steering N by N at 3 o'clock
the School of Juan having N by N

Monday May 2nd First part strong
breeze from S.E. but steering from the School
of Juan at 5 o'clock down to the School
reached off shore the School having S.W.
by N with at midnight middle beginning off
at 10 o'clock strong breeze from S.E. but at
7 o'clock left off steering N by N
