

1881 Remarks On board Bark *Antelope* Lewis

Wednesday May 25th Lat 5° 02' South
Lon 89° 55' West
First part fresh Trades from SE and
turning N N West. Employed in
ships duty until about 6 P M then
other light Trades from S S East
turning N N West again at 11 P M and
S Breeze saw Limbards

Thursday May 26th Lat 3° 40' South
Lon 90° 48' West
First part light Trades from S S
East turning N N West then led
the Wind & Breeze saw Limbards
middle steering N by N better
light Breeze from S S East turning
N by N employed in refueling at
Tepail

Friday May 27th Lat 2° 23' South
Lon 91° 09' West
First part fresh Breeze from S S East
turning N by N then finished refueling
the ship. A few Porpoises were
seen steering N by N better light Breeze
from S S East turning N N West at
sight of the Galapagos Islands. Sailed
Island & Albemarle saw Blackbird

Saturday May 28th Lat 1° 10' South
Lon 92° 10' West
First part light Breeze from S S East turning N N West
saw several small islands
bearing N N West then head middle
steering N N West better light Breeze from
South turning N N West employed in getting
and Beef & Pork & Water. The land
was sighted

Cruising Off Galapagos Islands

Sunday May 29th
Lat 1° 10' South
First part light Breeze from South steering
N by N then led in the wind with rain
and black stored down the oil
the Island of Harborough bearing East
by North 12 miles and ship at 12 better light
Breeze from South steering N by East

Monday May 30th Commenced with light
Breeze from South the ship steering N N West
at sundown with head bearing N N East
15 miles off middle of the line better light
employed in ships duty

Tuesday May 31st Commenced with
light Breeze from North by N N West
Harborough bearing East 15 miles off
saw Porpoises steering N N West
Breeze from South steering N by East with
head bearing N E by East saw Crabs

Wednesday June 1st Commenced with
light Breeze from S S East steering N N West
at 3 P M the rock bearing N N West
saw several Porpoises middle of the line
the ship at 12 better light Breeze from
South steering N N West the rock bearing
S S East saw Porpoises

Thursday June 2nd Commenced with
light Breeze from South steering N N West
head employed in making stowage on
at sundown the rock bearing S S
West middle steering N N West better light
Breeze from South steering N N West the
land in sight
