Sunday Oct 16th at 10⁰⁰ a.m. Breeze
with rain from S & S.W. at 10⁰⁰
got under way & started out
with 31 men. All told bend a new
fore spirit. Gits P. Schuman Master

Monday Oct 17th Fine. Breeze from S & S.W. working with
at 10⁰⁰ a.m. with all sail set at
10⁰⁰ a.m. the Island of Tobago being
at 6⁰⁰ a.m. 5 miles off. Tackled ship
at 6⁰⁰ a.m. heading S.E. by S. middle tack
one latter fresh breeze from S & S.W. at
heading. Wind with all sail set

Tuesday Oct 18th Fine. Breeze from S & S.W. at heading. Wind
tackled at sundown. Church rock
being at 10⁰⁰ a.m. 8 miles off. Tackled
sail. Observations from the
crown of the 150 miles. The East
middle steering. S. by S. South latter fresh
breeze from S & S.W. at heading S & S.W.

Wednesday Oct 19th Lat 2⁰⁰ 24⁰⁰ Lon 79⁰⁰ 23⁰⁰ W
Commenced with fresh breeze from S & S.W.
South heading S.E. by S. South with all sail set
middle heading S.E. by S. South latter light
N. breeze winds with rain from
S & S.W. to S.W.

Thursday Oct 20th Lat 6⁰⁰ 37⁰⁰ Lon 78⁰⁰ 25⁰⁰ W
Commenced with light breeze from N.W.
South heading S.E. by S. South with all sail set
not anything seen. A middle heading
S & S.W. latter light breeze with rain
from South heading S & S.W.

Friday Oct 21st Lat 5⁰⁰ 35⁰⁰ Lon 78⁰⁰ 25⁰⁰ W
Fine. Breeze from S & S.W. at heading
South heading S.E. by S. South with all sail set
not anything seen. A middle heading
S & S.W. latter light breeze from S & S.W.
with rain heading S & S.W.

Saturday Oct 22nd Lat 4⁰⁰ 15⁰⁰ Lon 77⁰⁰ 30⁰⁰ W
Commenced with fresh breeze from S & S.W.
heading South with all sail set not
anything seen. A middle heading
S & S.W. latter light breeze
from S & S.W. with rain heading S & S.W.

Sunday Oct 23rd The Observations
first part fresh breeze from S & S.W.
the S & S.W. the line from S & S.W. to
South with all sail set not anything seen
middle heading S.E. by S. South
the South latter rain in torrents. The
wind could not head anywhere.

Monday Oct 24th The Observations
first part rain. A light breeze
from S & S.W. at heading S & S.W.
not a heavy swell from S & S.W. did
not make much heading. Middle heading
latter calm. sighted the Island of
Gorgona being South 80 miles off.

Tuesday Oct 25th Lat 8⁰⁰ 12⁰⁰ Lon 75⁰⁰ 07⁰⁰ W
Commenced with light breeze from
N.W. at heading S & S.W. at 4⁰⁰ a.m. the
N.W. South with ship heading N.W. by N.
and down the gull's tail & returned. I
found it again. Middle heading S & S.W.
latter light breeze with rain from S & S.W.
heading S & S.W.
