Friday Dec 30<sup>th</sup> Lat 13 20 Lon 81 10 W  
First part fresh tracks from S E  
heaving E by East middle heaving  
the same better fresh Breeze from  
S E by East tack at 6 heaving S  
by East saw Finbacks

Saturday Dec 31<sup>st</sup> Lat 13 46 Lon 82 42  
First part fresh tracks from  
S East heaving E by East middle  
heaving E by East better fresh  
Breeze from S East heaving E by  
East but only thing seen employed  
in getting well water

First part fresh Breeze from S East  
heaving S East sails all set and  
made 4 heaving S East better fresh  
Breeze from S East heaving S East  
tack at 12 heaving E by East saw Finbacks

Tuesday Jan 3<sup>rd</sup> Lat 16 43 Lon 88 58 W  
Commenced with fresh tracks from S E by  
heaving E by East saw Finbacks middle  
heaving E by East better fresh Breeze from  
S East heaving E by East and nothing seen

Wednesday Jan 4<sup>th</sup> No Observations  
First part fresh Breeze & clouds from S East  
heaving E by East saw Suther Bottoms  
middle heaving E by East better light  
Breeze from S East heaving E by East  
tack at 12 saw Blackfish

Thursday Jan 5<sup>th</sup> Lat 14 00 Lon 90 00 W  
First part fresh tracks from S East  
heaving S East saw Peabodys  
middle heaving S East better light Breeze  
from S East to East tack at 10 1/2  
heaving E by East and down the major  
Spartan stays in the harbor set to drift  
the headstays at 10 mize now Suther Bottoms

Friday Jan 6<sup>th</sup> Lat 14 42 Lon 92 05 W  
First part fresh Breeze from S East  
heaving East finished repairing the stays  
& went to sea saw Finbacks middle heaving  
at 10 better light Breeze from S East heaving  
S East and saw Horn T. sail
