First fair fresh breeze from S.W.
Embarked in boiling & cutting up
the junk middle bottom better fresh
breeze from S.W. heading E.S.E. and
employed in boiling over Sulfur Bottoms

Sunday Feb 19th Lat 37.07 S Lon 75.44 W
Commenced with light breeze from
S.W. heading S.E. and the light
breeze on S.W. South better blowing
fresh from S.E. and employed in
boiling over ship at 10 heading
S.W.

Monday Feb 20th Lat 37.46 S Lon 75.12 W
First fair light breeze moderate gale
from S.E. and heading S.W. with
light fresh main S.W. and lower
staysails and finished boiling
middle breeze on the fresh gale from
S.E. and heading S.W. with light fresh
main S.W. and lower staysails and

Tuesday Feb 21st Lat 36.50 S Lon 75.40 W
First fair blowing fresh gale from
S.E. and heading S.W. with light
fresh main S.W. and lower staysails
and saw one sail at night the middle
more moderate better strong
breeze from S.E. and more at 10
heading S.W. saw Sulfur Bottoms

Wednesday Feb 22nd Lat 36.48 S Lon 76.18 W
First fair light breeze with heavy mist
from S.W. heading E.S.E. and middle heading
E.S.E. better light breeze from S.W. and
heading S.E. employed in storing the
oil between decks

Thursday Feb 23rd Lat 36.56 S Lon 75.27 W
First fair light breeze from S.W. heading
S.E. and finished storing down the oil
middle wind headed the S.W. at 4 started
S.W. better headed to S.W. with rain
squalls heading S.E. and at 10 raised a
low spray of water on the weather gauge
did not see him on one rising

Friday Feb 24th Lat 37.36 S Lon 75.13 W
Commenced with strong breeze from S.W.
heading S.E. and at 5 1/2 raised a school
of 8 or 9 whales giving the first blow
the boats the first & Bow Boats struck
at dark the whales about dead in the
ship working up the 16 whales the wind all
died away calm the boats towed
later at daylight got a breeze at 7 1/2 got
them along with got ready for cutting
at 11 hooked on two and ran

Saturday Feb 25th No other success
First fair fresh breeze from S.W. cut in
one of the whales middle one while
along side better strong breeze from S.W.
cut in the other whale

Sunday Feb 26th Lat 36.09 S Lon 76.41 W
First fair strong breeze from S.E. and heading
the head & Cleared away the 16 or 17 middle
commenced the Bail better fresh breeze from
W. heading S.W. and at 11 raised a school
the wind did not make sail the work of the
men could not make them out thought
they were sperm whales took it at 12
heading S.W. and employed in boiling
two sails in sight
