

Saturday August the 7th the 1847
the first part light winds from
E & heading S, a saw whales
at sunset took in sail the
middle and latter the same at
daylight made sail at 10 am
boarded the ship Charlotte of
Liverpool from Rio De Janeiro bound
to Hamburg at 11 came on board
Lat by Obs 35° 55' N Lon by Obs 44° 53'

Sunday August the 8th the 1847
the first part a fresh breeze from
E & heading S, a saw whales
weather at sunset put one reef
in the topsail the middle and the
same at daylight made sail at 6 am
tacked to the northward this day
Lat by Obs 35° 29' N Lon by Obs 44° 27'

Monday August the 9th the 1847
the first part a fresh breeze from
S & heading E, at sunset jibed out
reefed the topsail the middle the
same at daylight jibed the
reefs out and went to hoist the fore
topsail and covered away the yard
sent down the sail and yard and
went to work to fish it to ends
Lat by Obs 36° 45' N Lon by Obs 44° 20'

Tuesday August the 10th the 1847
the first part light winds from
E & heading W, at 10 am jibed
up the yard and bent the sail
at sunset took in sail
the middle calm at daylight made
sail latter light winds from W & W
steering E by S in flood in setting
up the fore and main rigging
saw whales this day and no whales
Lat by Obs 36° 51' N Lon by Obs 44° 29'

Wednesday August the 11th the 1847
the first part a fresh breeze from
W & W steering E & set up the top
mast rigging at sunset doubled reef
the topsail the middle squally with
heavy rain wind veering from W
to S at daylight very rainy with
a purpose at 9 am cleared up the
wind from W steering E by S
Lat by Obs 36° 10' N Lon by Obs 44° 47'

Thursday August the 12th the 1847
the first part moderate winds from
W & W steering S by E at 5 am the
wind shifted to the E & W were ship
to the S & W the same at daylight
the made sail latter on different tacks
the light from the Eastward one sail
in sight the watches in ship duty ends
Lat by Obs 36° 19' N Lon by Obs 42° 29' W

Friday August the 13th the 1847
the first part a nearly calm
on different tacks at 5:30 am saw
black fish found on track one
boat and brand at sunset came
on board and put one reef in the
topsail heading to the W the middle
and latter the same the watches
employed in in bracing out water and
flour work this day
Lat by Obs 36° 18' N Lon by Obs 42° 33'

Saturday August the 14th the 1847
the first part calm at 5:30 am saw
black fish board could not get up
to them at sunset came on board
and single reefed the topsail the
middle and latter light winds from
south steering E at daylight made
sail one sail in sight to ends
Lat by Obs 36° 26' N Lon by Obs 41° 53'
