

Sunday November the 27th the 1847
the first part strong trades steering
NW by S saw one sail seen from
porpoises at sunset took in sail and
luffed to the Westward the mid-
dle wind the same on different tacks
at daylight turned once reef out
of the topsail steered different
courses at 11:30 am to the wind to the
E & S so ends this day
Lat by Obs 21° 28' 11" Lon by Ch 18° 51'

Monday November the 28th the 1847
the first part strong winds from NW
heading E & S at sunset took in sail
and wore ship saw killers and fin backs
through the night on different tacks at
daylight made sail fresh trades heading
E & S saw fin backs so ends this day
Lat by Obs 21° 16' 14" Lon by Ch 18° 10'

Tuesday November the 9th the 1847
the first part strong winds at 5 PM
steering NW the watches I employed in
bracein out flour at 5 PM saw black
fish luffed to and board of boat and
struck one and board at sunset came
on board took in sail on different
tacks at daylight made sail headed
to the Eastward at 6 AM saw black
fish board and struck one of boat and
parted the iron strap at 8:30 AM
came on board headed to the Eastward
so ends Lat by Obs 20° 46'

Wednesday November the 10th the 1847
the first part moderate trades
heading to the Eastward at 1 PM saw
black fish board and struck one
I board and killed took him on board
at 4:30 PM board again for black
fish could not get fast at sunset
came on board took in sail and wore
ship to the westward middle strong
trades on different tacks at daylight
made sail headed to the E & S so ends
Lat by Obs 20° 46'

Thursday November the 11th the 1847
the first part strong trades heading
Eastward at 4 PM steered by compass
saw fin backs at 5:30 PM luffed to the
wind to the westward at sunset took
in sail the middle the same at daylight
set the fore sail headed to the NW 90°
saw fin backs so ends this day
Lat by Obs 20° 36' 58" Lon by Ch 17° 53'

Friday November the 12th the 1847
the first part strong trades and rugg
ged heading NW 90° under close reef tops
sails at 4 PM wore ship took in the
fore topsail and set the fore spencer the
middle the same at sunrise set the fore
topsail and wore ship to the NW 90° at 4 PM
set the fore topsail so ends this day
Lat by Obs 20° 58' 20" Lon by Ch 19° 07' West

Saturday November the 13th the 1847
the first part strong trades and rugg
ged heading to the Eastward under close reef
topsails and foresail saw porpoises at sun
set took in the fore topsail and fore sail
and wore ship the middle the same at
daylight set the fore sail at 8 AM set
the fore topsail so ends this day
Lat by Obs 20° 36' 58" Lon by Ch 19° 12' W

Sunday November the 14th the 1847
the first part strong trades and thick
smoky weather heading NW 90° at 5 PM
wore ship set the main sail at sunset
took in the main sail and fore topsail
the middle the same latter moderate
ated set gill and ~~main~~ mainsail and
turned one reef out of the main
topsail took ship saw porpoises
so ends this day

Lat by Obs 20° 38'
Lon by Ch 18° 45' W
