the first part moderate winds from
E & E heading at sunset took in sail
middle the same at daylight made sail
heading to the S latter heading the same
implaid in brain out water and bread
sends this day and no whales
Lat by Obs 15° 20' Lon by Ch 27° 36'

Friday Dec the 3th the 1847
the first moderate winds from the E
steering S by W filed the mauls
bowl saw white water run for it
did not see it again at sunset took in
sail middle and latter the same
saw one seal at daylight made
sail steard S by W so ends this day
Lat by Obs 11° 48' Lon by Ch 27° 49'

Saturday Dec the 4th the 1847
the first part fresh trades steard
W by N set the fore topmast stud
ingsail the middle and latter the same
so ends this day
Lat by Obs 11° 11' Lon by Ch 30° 30'

Sunday Dec the 5th the 1847
the first part strong trades steering
W by N by compass with all drawing sail
set middle and latter steard W by N
at 12 PM took the topgallentails in and
the studdingail at daylight set them
again sends this day
Lat by Obs 12° 07' Lon by Ch 33° 25'

Monday Dec the 6th the 1847
the first part strong trades steering
W by N by compass with all drawing sail
set the middle and latter the same
Lat by Obs 12° 35' N Lon by Ch 36° 00'

Tuesday December the 7th the 1847
the first strong trades and rugged and
cloudy weather steering W by N took in
the studdingail sail and fore top gallent
sail the middle and latter the same
at daylight set the fore top gallent
sail and studdingail sends this day
Lat by Obs 12° 52' N Lon by Ch 41° 00'

Wednesday December the 8th the 1847
the first part strong trades and
cloudy with some light rain steering
W by N middle the same at 10 AM took
studdingail and fore top gallent sail at
day light set the studdingail again the
latter steard the same so ends this day
Lat by Obs 12° 35' N Lon by Ch 43° 00'

Thursday December the 9th the 1847
the first part strong trades and
nearly clear steering W by N at 5 PM
set fore top gallentail the middle and
latter brish topes and clear weather
steering W by N sends this day
Lat by Obs 12° 46' N Lon by Ch 46° 00'

Friday December the 10th 1847
the first part moderate trades
steering W by N by compass set
up the topstays and gib quize
the middle and latter the same the
watcher implaid in various things to
numerous to mention so ends this day
Lat by Obs 12° 53' N Lon by Ch 48° 11'

Saturday December the 11th 1847
the first part moderate trades
from N E steering W the middle some
small rain wind veering steering W by N
latter had fresh trades steard the
same so ends Lat 12° 26' Lon by Ch 51° 00'
