

Thursday April the 17th the 1848
the first part a brisk breeze from
N.E. and clear weather steering N.W.
implied to work on the wheel
saw several sails saw a pinback
at sunset shortened sail middle
the same at daylight made sail
the wind from the E. and fine
weather steering N.W. latter
the wind from S.W. heading
N.W. the watches implied in
line in put for water so ends
Sat by Obs 27° 57' N Lon by the 77° 00'

Thursday April the 20th the 1848
the first part moderate winds
from N.W. heading N.W. at 4pm
the wind shifted to S.W. took
in main top galant sail and main
sail and tacked ship at 3pm
the wind N.W. wore ship at 4pm
the wind shifted to S.W. headed to
the S.W. through the night the
same daylight made sail at 4pm
steered N.W. so ends this day
Sat by Obs 28° 00' N Lon by the 77° 50'

Friday April the 21st the 1848
the first part fresh winds from
S.E. steering N.W. at 4pm
luffed to the S.W. at sunset short-
ened sail and wore ship the middle
on different tacks at daylight made
sail heading northward one sail in
sight at 8pm wore ship so ends
Sat by Obs 28° 30' N Lon by the 79° 00'

Saturday April the 22nd the 1848
the first part moderate winds
from E.S.E. heading to the southward
at 5pm tacked at sunset shortened
sail the middle the same at daylight
made sail heading to the N. saw two
sails at ~~daylight~~ 12 o'clock tacked
ship so ends this day
Sat by Obs 29° 00' N Lon by the 78° 30'

Sunday April the 23rd the 1848
the first part a fresh breeze from
S.E. heading N.W. at 5pm tacked
at sunset took in sail the middle
the same at daylight made sail with
a fresh breeze from the south and thick
weather heading E.S.E. at 10pm and
reefed the topsails saw one sail so ends
Sat by Obs 29° 50' N Lon by the 77° 20'

Monday April the 24th the 1848
the first part strong winds from S.W.
heading E. saw one sail steering to
the north and east at sunset took in
sail and wore ship through the night
the same at daylight had a thunder
squall at 10am cleared up took a fresh
breeze from N.W. heading S.W. implied to
work on the wheel so ends this day
Sat by Obs 28° 00' N Lon by the 77° 20'

Tuesday April the 25th the 1848
the first part moderate winds from
W. and clear weather heading S.W.
at sunset took in sail and wore
ship through the night nearly calm
at day light made all sail at 10am
took a light breeze from E.S.E. heading
S. saw grasshoppers implied to work
on the wheel so ends this day
Sat by Obs 27° 40' N Lon by the 77° 50'

Wednesday April the 26th the 1848
the first part moderate winds from
E.S.E. heading S. at 4pm tacked ship
at sunset took in sail the middle the
same at 10pm wore ship at daylight
made sail heading N.W. latter the same
implied to work on the wheel so ends
Sat by Obs 27° 45' N Lon by the 78° 15'
