

Thursday April the 27th the 1848
the first part moderate winds
from S and veering heading to the
westward at sunset took ship and
took in sail middle the same
on different tack at daylight
made sail heading to the eastward
at 9 AM took in, took at
10 AM sat in to main stand S
so ends this day
Lat by Obs 20° 00' N Lon by Dr 78° 00'

Friday April the 28th the 1848
the first part light winds from
SSE and rain, steering S at 10 AM
took up some saw three sperm whales
board but they had perceived us
could not on to them at dark came
on board and took in sail heading
to the S the middle the same at
daylight made sail heading ESE
at 6 AM took in, latter the same
saw a grampus so ends this day
Lat by Obs 28° 00' N Lon by Dr 78° 30'

Saturday April the 29th the 1848
the first part of these 24 hours
begins with a fresh breeze from S E
heading SSE at 4 PM steered W at
6 PM wore ship at sunset took in
sail for the night middle the same
at daylight made sail heading ESE
latter moderate steering N N W so ends
Lat by Obs 29° 00' N Lon by Dr 78° 40'

Sunday April the 30th the 1848
the first part moderate winds from
SE heading N N W at sunset took in
sail and heeled to the wind to the
ESE middle the same at daylight
made sail heading ESE at 10 AM
took ship saw a ship heading to the
Eastward so ends this day
Lat by Obs 29° 45' N Lon by Dr 78° 20'

Monday May the 1st the 1848
the first part light winds from
SE and veering heading to the South
and West at sunset shortened sail
the middle and latter the same at
daylight made all sail heading Eastward
the watches imployed in bracing out for
water and rollers so ends one sail in sight
Lat by Obs 29° 30' N Lon by Dr 78° 05'

Tuesday May the 2nd the 1848
the first part nearly calm imployed
in hoisting off barrels at 6 AM heard
for blackfish did not get fast at
dark came on board and shortened
sail through the night light winds
from the S on different tack at daylight
made sail heading SE latter the same
saw one sail so ends this day
Lat by Obs 29° 16' N Lon by Dr 77° 10' W

Wednesday May the 3rd the 1848
the first part moderate winds from
the S heading ESE at 6 PM took in
at sunset shortened sail middle the
same at daylight squally at 8 AM
cleared up the wind from W heading
SW to work on the wheel so ends
Lat by Obs 28° 44' N Lon by Dr 77° 35'

Thursday May the 4th the 1848
the first part moderate winds from
N N W and veering to N N W heading to
the westward saw a sail steering to
the Eastward at sunset shortened sail
the middle light winds heading N N W at
daylight made sail at 6 AM steered S W
saw three sails latter the same so ends this day
Lat by Obs 28° 19' N Lon by Dr 78° 00' W

Friday May the 5th the 1848
the first part light winds from E steering N N W
at sunset took in sail and heeled to the S the
middle and latter the same at daylight
made sail heading to the southward saw
sails saw three sails so ends this day
Lat by Obs 27° 54' N Lon by Dr 79° 21' W
