

Tuesday August the 15th the 1848
the first part light winds from
N heading NNE implaid in packing
one sail in sight through the night
the same at 3 am had a squall of rain
latter good weather ends this day

Wednesday August the 16th the 1848
the first part moderate winds from
the N heading westward implaid in
boiling at 4 PM finished boiling
the rest of the night moderate
latter do implaid stowing down
saw one sail so ends this day
Lat by Obs 35° 25' N Long by Obs 99° 00'

Thursday August the 17th the 1848
the first part light winds from
the northward heading westward
implaid in stowing down the oil
stuck all the day and three
casks of hemp through the night
the same at daylight made sail head
in N at 10 am tacked ship latter
moderate wind all hands implaid
in stowing down at 12 o'clock tacked
one sail in sight so ends this day
Lat by Obs 35° 25' N Long by Obs 98° 50'

Friday August the 18th the 1848
the first part light winds from the
northward heading NNE at
10 am finished stowing down
and washed off at sunset took
in topgallant sail and tacked ship
middle on different tack at day
light set topgallant sail latter
the same the watches implaid
in fitting the head straps and
other small jobs so ends this day
Lat by Obs 32° 52' N Long by Obs 98° 10'

Saturday August the 19th the 1848
the first part light winds from
N heading NE at 5 PM wore
ship at sunset took in the light sails
through the night nearly the same at
daylight made sail took the wind from E
steered NNE and different courses implaid
main bunnies so ends this day
Lat by Obs 35° 05' N Long by Obs

Sunday August the 20th the 1848
the first part a fresh breeze from Eastward
several sails in sight steered different
courses at 4 PM had a squall of rain
took in the light sails and chide down
the topsails at 5 PM set the topsails
steered NNE at sunset took in
the fore topsail and doubled reefed the
main and hove to the wind by the night
through the night good weather at day
light made sail heading NE by the wind
at 10 am steered NNE so ends this day
Lat by Obs 35° 35' N Long by Obs 99° 35' W

Monday August the 21st the 1848
the first part a fresh breeze from SE
steering N by compass caught a porpoise
saw gumpers saw a hawk heading NE
at sunset took in sail and luffs to
the wind to the southward through
the night the same latter at day
light made sail NNE steered saw
two sails so ends this day
Lat by Obs 36° 30' N Long by Obs 41° 00' W

Tuesday August the 22nd the 1848
the first part a fresh breeze from
SE steering N saw a brig steering
to the NE at 5 PM picked up a large
pine log for wood at sunset took
in sail and luffs to the wind to the
NE through the night on different tacks
at daylight made sail at 7 am steered
NNE saw one sail so ends this day
Lat by Obs 32° 45' N Long by Obs 42° 00' W
