

Sunday Sept the 24th the 1848
the first part fresh winds from
E and cloudy heading NNE & saw
bunches men for them did not
see the more through the
night moderate but thick
latter nearly calm and
clear weather sited a sail so ends
Lat by Obs 37° 10' N Lon by Ch 50° 49'

Monday Sept the 25th the 1848
the first part nearly calm
heading NE at 10:00 we sited
blackfish yard and chased
could not get up to them
at 8:00 came on board the
middle calm latter a light wind
from the N steering E imbold
brain out for water and bread
several sails in sight so ends
Lat by Obs

Tuesday Sept the 26th the 1848
the first part light winds
from the northward and
veering several sails in sight
through the night had a fine
breeze from NE steering E by S
latter the same one sail in
sight so ends this day
Lat by Obs 37° 5' N Lon by Ch 31° 40'

Wednesday Sept the 27th the 1848
the first part a fresh breeze
from the N steering E by S
saw killers through the night
wind from NE and veering and
thick cloudy with some rain heading
E by S and E S E at sunrise sited the
the side of Sico latter the wind
cutted to NE & headed E saw several
saw a sail so ends this day

Thursday Sept the 28th the 1848
the first part moderate winds
from NE & heading E at 2:00 pm
the wind shifted E S E & headed to
NE saw two sails at sunset took
ship the N part of the day
saw 15 miles through the night the
same latter wind from the E S E heading
E one sail in sight so ends this day
Lat by Obs 37° 30' N Lon by Ch

Friday Sept the 29th the 1848
the first part light winds from
Eastward steering E by E middle
the same latter the same imbold
in washing the brig round and
cleaning the iron work so ends
Lat by Obs 36° 45' N Lon by Ch 27° 50'

Saturday Sept the 30th the 1848
the first part light winds from
E steering S by E imbold in washing
and scraping the brig at sunset took
in sail the middle weather the
same at 4:00 pm shifted to the wind
to the wind S E latter wind
NE heading Eastward so ends
Lat by Obs 35° 15' N Lon by Ch 26° 40'

Sunday Oct the 1st the 1848
the first part a fresh breeze
from NE & heading E S E at
sunset shortened sail for night
through the night the same at day
light thick weather heading
E under pulled reefed topsail at
8:00 am sited some set gill and try sail
so ends Lat by Obs 36° 10' N Lon 25° 28'

Monday Oct the 2nd the 1848
the first part part strong gales
from NE at 11:00 am steered S E at
sunset took in fore topsail and headed
to the wind through the night the
same at day light more moderate
made sail steered S E latter the
same so ends
