

Tuesday Oct the 3th the 1848
the first part a fresh breeze
from E. & heading S. E. caught
a turtle at sunset took in
sail through the night calm
at daylight the same light
moderate wind from S heading
S. E. set a sail so ends this day
Lat by Obs 35° 26' N Lon by Ch 23° 20'

Wednesday Oct the 4th the 1848
the first part fresh breeze
from N. W. and veering heading
S. E. at sunset a gale took in
sail through the night strong
wind at daylight set doubled
reef topsails at 8 am wore ship
head at W. set a brig steering
Eastward so ends this day
Lat by Obs 35° 14' N Lon by Ch 21° 16' W

Thursday Oct 5th the first part
strong winds from S. W. and very
rough heading W. at 4 pm took
in fore topsail at 5 o'clock reefed
the main topsail at sunset wore
ship took in fore sail and took
up the lee bauls through the
night strong gale took in the
main topsail at day rather more
moderate set main topsail and
fore sail at 1 pm set doubled
reef topsails and gave the wind
from W. heading S. E. so ends
this day Lat by Obs 35° 10' N Lon by Ch 21° 20'

Friday Oct the 6th the 1848
the first part strong winds from
W. & heading S. E. sent down
topmast yards through the
night moderate at daylight
made sail wind from W heading
S. E. sent up the main topmast yard
filled the foot of the mast boats
down and began where they give
way so ends this day
Lat by Obs 34° 30' N

Saturday Oct the 7th the 1848
the first part moderate winds
W heading S. E. sent a turtle at
sunset wore ship and shortened
sail through the night the same
at daylight made sail latter light
winds from the W steering W. S. W.
passed the Labrador boat so ends
Lat by Obs 35° 35' N Lon by Ch 21° 02' W

Sunday Oct the 8th the 1848
the first part light winds from
W steering W. S. W. sent in the gill
and repaired it at 3 pm bent it
set a sail at sunset took in the
light sails at day through the night
the same at daylight set topmast sail
the wind S steering W by compass saw
a sail so ends this day
Lat by Obs 35° 40' N Lon by Ch 21° 55'

Monday Oct the 9th the 1848
the first part light winds from E
and good weather steering W by S
at sunset took in topmast sail
through the night the same at
daylight made sail steered W commen-
ced rattin down so ends this day
Lat by Obs 32° 45' N Lon by Ch 29° 57'

Tuesday Oct the 10th the 1848
the first part moderate winds from
E. & steering W. impleid rattin at
sunset shortened sail and luffed to
the wind to the S the middle the same
at daylight made sail impleid
rattin the topmast rigging set a
sail set a subperbottom so ends
Lat by Obs 32° 20'
