

Monday Nov the 6th the 1848
the first part a fresh breeze
from S steering W by S at 5 PM
took in the standing sail through
the night wind S W and squally
at 11 PM took in my topgallant sails
at 1 PM took in the fore topgallant
and last reefed the main latter
latter moderated some set back
but reefed topsails and courses
so ends this day
Lat by Obs 21° 00' Lon by Ch 42° 45'

Tuesday Nov the 7th the 1848
the first part strong winds from
S W and rugged heavily to the S W
the middle wind W by N heading
W latter wind the same at 4 PM
more ship so ends this day
Lat by Obs 34° 44' Lon by Ch 45° 12'

Wednesday Nov the 8th the 1848
the first part strong winds from
W by N heading S W at 6 PM turned
the reefs out of the topsails and set
main topgallant sail through nearly
calm latter a light air from the
W steering W by S broke out for wood
one of our passengers very sick
with a fever so ends this day
Lat by Obs 20° 45' Lon by Ch 45° 45'

Thursday Nov the 9th the 1848
the first part light wind and
bafin from the S steering W
middle part wind bafin at day
light took a light breeze from E by S
set topmast standing sail steered W by S
latter the same commenced a bore
standing sail Frederick these very
sick so ends this day
Lat by Obs 20° 38' Lon by Ch 44° 58'

Friday Nov the 10th the 1848
the first part a brisk breeze
from E by S steering W by S finished
the standing sail and set it mid
day the same steered W by S
latter the trades rather stronger
so ends this day the sick man
very low Lat 21° 05' Lon 47° 05'

Saturday Nov the 11th the 1848
the first part fine trades
steering W by N through the
night the same latter do
so ends the sick man very low
Lat by Obs 21° 48' Lon by Ch 49° 00'

Sunday Nov the 12th the 1848
the first part fine trades steering
W by N by 9 saw a brig steering to
the Northward through the night
the same latter wind do steered
the same at 9 PM not Frederick
these sick laid him out so ends
Lat by Obs 22° 28' Lon by Ch 50° 55'

Monday Nov the 13th the 1848
the first part light winds from
E by S steering W by S at 4 PM
luffed to the wind and committed
the baddy to the reef laid a
few minutes and left on our
courses at 4:30 PM took a squall
from N W took in to doubled reef
topsails at 5 PM the wind hauled
to N E and thick and rainy steered
W by S at 8:30 PM luffed up
turned the reefs out of the main
topgallant and set topgallant sail
through the night wind light
and bafin from S by E at 11 PM
turned the reefs out of the fore
topgallant and set topgallant sail and
standing sail latter the same broke
out water and meet so ends
Lat by Obs 29° 20' Lon by Ch 53° 00'
