

Tuesday Nov the 14th the 1848
the first part moderate winds
from NE and veering to SE steering
WNW middle the same but
at daylight the wind shifted
the starboard latter wind S and
veering steering WNW copied
Hoses chest found 811.80cts in cash
and sold the chest and contents
for 99.50cts so ends this day
Lat by Obs 25° 51' 5" Lon by Ch 57° 15'

Wednesday Nov the 15th the 1848
the first part light winds from
S and veering to N heading to
the north and west took in studd
ing sail at 6 AM took a breeze from N
steered WNW at 8 AM the wind shifted
to NW and thick and rainey doubled
reef the topsails at daylight nearly
calm made all sail better calm so ends
Lat by Obs 24° 12' 30" Lon by Ch 56° 15' W

Thursday Nov the 16th the 1848
the first part calm middle the
same at sunrise took a breeze
from N steered N by W
pinned the starboard boat
latter a fresh breeze so ends
Lat by Obs 24° 50' 18" Lon by Ch 46° 50'

Friday Nov the 17th the 1848
the first part strong winds
from S heading N by W by W
at 5 PM the W by W in a
squal took in to doubled reef
topsails at 6 PM set gill and main
sail through the night squally wind
all round the compass on different tracks
latter wind from S W and veering
to N W heading N and West so ends
Lat by Obs 25° 15' 6" Lon by Ch 57° 10' W

Saturday Nov the 18th the 1848
the first part moderate winds
from N and veering to NE steering
W by N the middle wind N steered
the same at daylight the wind
blew to NE set topmast studding sail
latter the same so ends this day
Lat by Obs 25° 50' 1" Lon by Ch 57° 15'

Sunday Nov the 19th the 1848
the first part strong winds from
NE steering N by N and W by N
middle wind E steering N by N latter
the same so ends this day
Lat by Obs 26° 44' 8" Lon by Ch 61° 40' W

Monday Nov the 20th the 1848
the first part moderate winds
from E steering W by N through
the night winds the same steered
N by N latter light winds from SE
steering the same sent in the gill
to repair sited a sail so ends this day

Tuesday Nov the 21st the 1848
the first part light winds from SE
steering N by N by N bent the gill
at 3 AM set away calm latter the
same nearly impleid in bracing out
water so ends this day
Lat by Obs 27° 43' 18"

Wednesday Nov the 22nd the 1848
the first part nearly calm broke
out breeze through the night light
wind SE and veering steering N by N
at daylight took a fresh breeze from
W by N heading N W sited three sails
so ends Lat by Obs 28° 16' 5" Lon by Ch 64° 40' W
