Three 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from SE & smooth weather
staring North watch employed in ships duty various kinds of work
middle & latter part of the day fine breeze from SE & smooth weather
staring North watch employed in ships duty the day ends fine breeze
Set in by 4.00 South Long in by chronometer 38.30 west

at 10 PM saw a large & fine sail on the horizon

271 Remarks on Sunday March 30th 1850
Three 24 hours begins with strong breeze from SE & thick rain
weather staring North watch employed in ships duty the day ends
light breeze & fresh breeze by shifts from SE to S by & colors by shifts &
rain & shifts at 10 PM saw a school of small blackfish leeward
the barboard boat could not get past came on board the day ends with
a light breeze from SE & small rain
Set in by 4.10 South Long in by chronometer 40.17 west

at 10 PM saw a large & fine sail on the horizon

Three 24 hours begins with a light breeze from SE & cloudy weather
staring North at 3 calm at 4 a light breeze spring up from the SE
middle & latter part of the day fine breeze & fine weather staring
North watch employed in ships duty saw a new wheel rope
& fitted the blocks & work on the old top sail the day ends with
fine weather & a fine breeze from SE
Set in by 4.31 South Long in by chronometer 38.09 west

at 10 PM saw a large & fine sail on the horizon

273 Remarks on Tuesday March 5th 1850
Three 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from SE & fine weather
under all sail staring North watch employed in repairing the
old top sail at 10 PM finished it middle & latter part of the day equally
by shifts & the wind variable from North to SE watch employed in ships
duty the day ends cloudy weather wind from SE staring North
Set in by 4.17 South Long in by chronometer 39.10 west

at 10 PM saw a large & fine sail on the horizon

274 Remarks on Wednesday March 6th 1850
Three 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from SE & cloudy weather
under all sail staring North watch employed in ships duty
middle & latter part of the day fine breeze from SE & fine
weather staring North at 11 star entered at 11 watch employed
in ships duty finished the new boat overboard the day ends fine weather
Set in by 4.02 South Long in by chronometer 40.17 west

at 10 PM saw a large & fine sail on the horizon

275 Remarks Thursday March 7th 1850
Three 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from SE & fine
weather under all sail staring North watch employed in
ships duty middle & latter part of the day moderate breeze from SE
the day staring North at 11 star entered at 11 watch employed
in ships duty finished the new boat overboard the day ends fine weather
Set in by 4.10 South Long in by chronometer 41.30 west

at 10 PM saw a large & fine sail on the horizon

276 Remarks on Friday March 8th 1850
Three 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from SE & fine weather
staring North watch employed in repairing the old boat at 11
PM finished her & put her overboard middle part of the day fine
breeze & fine weather latter part equally by shifts & fresh breeze
the day ends the same Long in by chronometer 43.16 west
Set in by 4.33 South Long in by chronometer 43.33 west

at 10 PM saw a large & fine sail on the horizon

277 Remarks on Saturday March 9th 1850
Three 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from East & equally by shifts
staring North at 8 PM took in top gallantsails & reefed the topsails
both the lee boats on upper cranes strong winds ruggid sea on & equally
ship looking bad saw her bow latter part of the day more moderate
but strong breeze at 8 PM turned out reefs & set top gallantsails at
10 saw several fishbacks whale saw porpoises the day ends strong breeze
Set in by 4.00 South Long in by chronometer 45.00 west

at 10 PM saw a large & fine sail on the horizon

278 Remarks on Sunday March 10th 1850
Three 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from SE & ruggid sea on Sunday
staring North middle & latter part of the day fresh breeze & passing
clouds staring North no manometer sick & off duty the day ends the same
Set in by 4.01 South Long in by chronometer 46.10 west

at 10 PM saw a large & fine sail on the horizon

279 Remarks on Monday March 11th 1850
Three 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from SE & passing clouds
staring North at 10 PM saw a strong sail off on weather beam staring
North middle & latter part of the day strong breeze & ruggid sea on at 10 PM
took in the top gallantsails at 5 PM set them saw the strong sail ahead
the day ends strong breeze staring North
Set in by 4.04 South Long in by chronometer 47.15 west
