3 Remarks on Monday June 30 1850
The 24 hours begin with a fine breeze from South & fine weather & steering by the wind to the E. S. E. one merchant barge to the landward steering the same at sun down ref^d tobacco inside & latter part of the day fine breeze & fine weather steering by the wind bearing E. S. E. at 5 a m made all sail saw a melopoe east at 7 in bent the main sail & commenced repairing it the day was fine weather set in by 10 31.51 at 11 in by 12 down to 13 at 1.13 west
