all sail watch employed in ships duty rattling the starboard main shrouse
& at 11 AM exchange signals with a Swedish norwegian brig steering to the N.E.

saw pumps the day ends with a fine breeze from N.W. & fine weather

latter part of the day fine breeze from S.W. & popping clouds & several showers
of rain at 5 made sail saw one strong sail of our weather beam watch employed
in ships duty rattling the larboard fore shrouse but the new main topmast sail
& commenced repairing the old one the day ends with a fine breeze & fine weather
