we 24 hours before with a fresh breeze from the south & passing close
to the windward having with it a fresh breeze on ship to the leeward steering
to windward to the eastward made a little part of the day fresh breeze from ex-
posed steering to the wind to the west to the day made with fine breeze &
passing clouds several days in sight
Left in 1704 35.18 is long in 2 Chronometer 71.50 west

at 1 PM saw manta light
at 10 PM came to anchor
off western harbor.

then 211 hours begins with fine pleasant weather & nearly calm water
employed in ships duty sent up the royal yards below down the to get some
cod fish could not at 2 a light air spring up from the N. he made all
sail & steers from NE to E at 8 at 10 PM saw mistack light at 1
a M stars & NE at 3 saw black island latter part of the day fine
bears from NW N W & fair weather at 8 a M called all hands & got
up the chains & bent them to the anchors & got all ready for anchoring
at 10 AM came to anchor within the two mile rock & furled sails
& went on shore to the point the day new fine weather laying to
anchor outside the harbour
