

Remarks on Board Bark *Thetis* 1862

Monday March 18

This day commences with a fine Breeze from S west with clear weather ship heading upon distant anchor all sail made and later part the same so ends the day
Left by 12.30
Long by 11.30

Tuesday March 19

This day commences with a fine Breeze from South with clear weather ship heading in S in middle all sail made later part the same later part ship heading East so ends the day
Left by 12.30
Long by 11.30

Wednesday March 20

This day commences with a strong Breeze from S west with clear weather ship heading East under all sail middle part ship upon distant tack at day light saw the coast of Africa later part the same so ends the day
Left by 12.30
Long by 11.30

Thursday March 21

This day commences with a strong Breeze from S west with smoky weather ship heading upon distant tack middle part the same at day light saw the land later part ship upon distant tack so ends the day
Left by 12.30
Long by 11.30

Friday March 22

This day commences with a fine Breeze from S west with smoky weather ship heading upon distant tack all sail cut middle part the same at day light saw the land later part the same so ends the day

of *West* from *Alfred* Taver *Master*

Monday March 23

1862

This day commences with fine Breeze from S west with clear weather ship heading South at 4 P in came to anchor in little fish Bay middle part the same later part employed watering

Tuesday March 24

This day commences with fine weather employed in get water at 6 P in brought a raft ~~onboard~~ on board later part weather the same so ends the day

Wednesday March 25

This day commences with a fine Breeze from S west with clear weather ship Still at anchor at little fish Bay middle part rainy one of the men that came on liberty got put in the foot drunk brought him on board and put him in iron employed in getting water later part fine weather so ends the day

Thursday March 26

This day commences with fine weather employed watering at 4 P in potatoes and came on board at 6 P in back Log cut of iron middle part weather the same later part got a raft on water so ends this day

Friday March 27

This day commences with a fine Breeze from S west employed in getting ready for sea
