

Remarks on Board of Bark Malapiscott of
Friday April 3 1867

This day commences with a strong breeze from
S East with cloudy weather ship dismasted courses
at sun down double reef the top sails and
putt by wind ship heading E S East
middle and later part ship heading upon dismasted
tack so ends the day

Saturday April 6

This day commences with fine breeze from
S East with clear weather ship under double reef
top sails and courses heading upon dismasted tack
middle part the same later part heading E S East
so ends the day

Salt by lb 11.00
Sung by Com 4.35

Sunday April 7

This day commences with a fine breeze from
S East with clear weather ship heading E S East
at sundown tack in sail for the night and
putt by the wind heading E S East middle
part the same at day light saw two sails later
part the same so ends the day

Monday April 8

This day commences with a fine breeze from
S East with clear weather ship heading E S East
at 1 P.M. saw Island of St Helena and a
number of at sun down S west Bent distant
20 miles at 4 P.M. spoke the Ben Franklin
of New Bedford 11 months out 180 bbls of oil
middle part ship upon dismasted tack later part
saw number of sails so ends the day

This day commences with a fine breeze from
S East with clear weather ship heading dismasted
courses at sun down St Helena distant 6 miles
at 1 P.M. spoke the Union of Sag Harbor
and Ben Franklin of New Bedford middle part
ship upon dismasted tack day 1 of 1867
heading E S East so ends the day

Wednesday April 10

This day commences with a strong breeze from
S East with cloudy weather ship heading E S East
under all sail middle and part the same so ends
day

S East with clear weather ship heading E S East

so ends the day
