

Remarks on Board Bark Malapiscott of West
Wednesday April 14 1867

This day Commences with a fine Breeze from
SEast with clear weather ship heading E by N
under all sail middle part the same
At 12 M luff by wind ship heading
E by East all sail in reef off E by west at
11 M in rain & sail so ends the day

Long by Com 13.51 W

Thursday April 15

This day Commences with a fine Breeze from
SEast with clear weather ship heading E by N
at 2 P M Island of Ascension at sun down distant
30 miles tack in sail and luff by the wind
heading East by North middle part ship
upon distant tacks later part employed in
manning the fore sail so ends the day

Friday April 16

This day Commences with a strong Breeze from
SEast with clear weather ship heading E by N
employed manning the fore sail at sun
down land in site bearing W by South
distant 15 miles middle and later part ship
upon distant tack saw 1 sail so ends the day

Saturday April 17

This day Commences with a strong Breeze from
SEast with clear weather ship heading E by N
under top sail and courses at sun down land
bearing E by N distant 30 miles middle
part ship heading upon distant tack later
part ship heading East by North under
top sails and courses so ends the day

Thursday April 15 1867

This day Commences with a strong Breeze from
SEast with clear weather ship heading E by N
At 1 P M make the vision of Sagharan
Land in site distant 35 miles middle
and later part ship upon distant tacks so
ends the day

This day Commences with a strong Breeze from
SEast with clear weather ship heading E by N
courses saw 2 sails at sun down land distant
28 miles Bearing E by East middle and later
part ship upon distant tacks so ends the day

Saturday April 17

This day Commences with a fine Breeze from
SEast with clear weather ship heading E by N
at sun down land Bearing E by East distant 25
miles middle and later part the same so
ends the day

Sunday April 18

This day Commences with a fine Breeze from
SEast with clear weather ship heading E by N
under all sail middle and later part the same
so ends the day

SEast with clear weather ship heading E by N
under all sail middle and later part the same
so ends the day
