Thursday May 30 1867

This day Commences with a strong Breeze
west west with clear weather ship heading
west at sun down tack in sail and
were ship heading North & sails in sight
middle part the same latter part the
same so ends the day

This day Commences with a fine Breeze
from west with clear weather ship heading

This day Commences with a strong Breeze from
west with smoky weather ship heading
East at sun down I tack in sail for the
night and luff by the wind heading North
middle and latter part the same so ends the
day

This day Commences with a strong Breeze
from west with clear weather ship heading
upon discreant tacks middle part rainy
latter part cloudy weather saw 1 sail
so ends the day

This day Commences with a fine Breeze
from N. W. to N. East with clear weather
ship heading west middle and latter part
clear weather ship heading discreant courses
so ends the day

This day Commences with a strong Breeze
from N. W. to N. East with clear weather
ship heading discreant courses middle part
the same latter part fine Breeze from
N. East ship heading N. W. so ends
the day

Wednesday June 5

This day Commences with a fine Breeze
from N. East with clear weather ship heading
N. W. under all sail at sun down
tack in sail for the night middle and
latter part the same so ends the day

Thursday June 6

This day Commences with light Breeze from
N. East with clear weather ship heading
discreant courses at 4 P. M. saw black fish
toward the three Boats and struck the
barbed Beal drove brought others
to the ship middle part calm at 7 P. M.
saw Black fish toward the three Boats and
struck and brought them to the ship
so ends the day
