

Remarks on board Bark Mattapirett

Monday July 22

1867

This day commences with light breeze from west with thick rainy weather ship heading, depeant coes pick up 1 bbl of petroleum oil and 1 plank middle and latter part the same so ends the day

Tuesday July 23

This day commences with a fine breeze from west with fine weather ship heading depeant coes at 2 P.M. saw 3 sperm whales toward the boats. Two harpoon boats went a long side of one but the iron did not go in at 4 P.M. the first boat struck and brought the whale to the ship at 11 P.M. Middle part employed in cutting. So ends this day.

Wednesday July 24

This day commences with a fine breeze from west ship heading different coes. Men employed cutting the whale. Spoke bark Orlando of N. Bedford. 3 month out, clean. Middle part employed in cutting, latter part, boiling. So ends this day.

This day commences with a fine breeze from west with fine weather. Men employed in boiling. Middle and latter part the same so ends the day.

1867

This day commences with fine breeze from N.W. with clear weather ship heading E employed in boiling. Middle and latter part the same. So ends this day.

This day commences with a fine breeze from N.W. ship heading different coes. Employed in boiling at 11 P.M. finished boiling latter part employed in stowing down so ends the day.

This day commences with a fine breeze from N.W. with fine weather ship heading upon depeant coes employed in stowing down oil middle and latter part weather the same so ends the day.

This day commences with a fine breeze from N.W. with clear weather ship heading N.W. with middle part the same latter part employed in stowing down oil so ends the day.
